Project Background (PALIB)

The Palestinian Research and Library Platform (PALIB) project is co-funded by the Erasmus+ program of the European Union. This project aims to enhance the capacity building of Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) by widening the access of Palestinian students, academicians, and researchers to digital library resources. This will be achieved by building a cross-platform that has two main objectives as follows:

- Connecting all library digital items across all local HEIs and centers.
- Building a customizable research portal for Palestinian HEIs concerning different research aspects.

Project objectives

PALIB project considers the following objectives to be achieved:

- Enhancing the infrastructure of local libraries in Palestine, including libraries in HEIs.
- Providing large-scale accessible databases for students and researchers.
- Enhancing the research infrastructure in Palestine.
- Providing a sustainable platform to incrementally increase the library digital assets on the database.
- Transferring the European experience on building such databases, such as hal.archives-ouvertes.fr.
